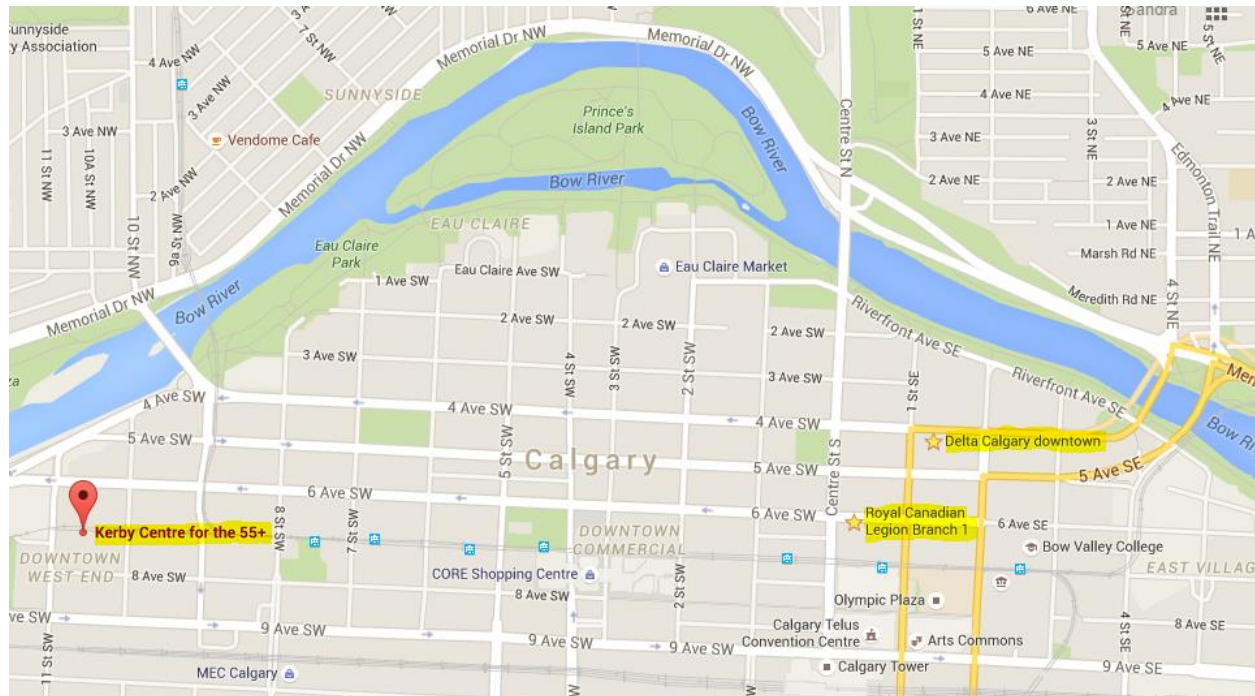


Puppet Power 2016 LOCATION & DIRECTIONS

Puppet Power 2016 is taking place at the **Kerby Centre** (1133-7th Ave. SW) in Calgary, Alberta, Canada. Calgary is in Western Canada, situated close to the Rocky Mountains, North of Montana. If you are travelling by car, parking is available at the Kerby Centre. Parking is free on the North side of the Kerby Centre and on the other side of the C-train line and no parking pass is required on the weekend. > [click for Google Map](#)

GETTING TO THE KERBY CENTRE FROM THE DELTA HOTEL via CTrain

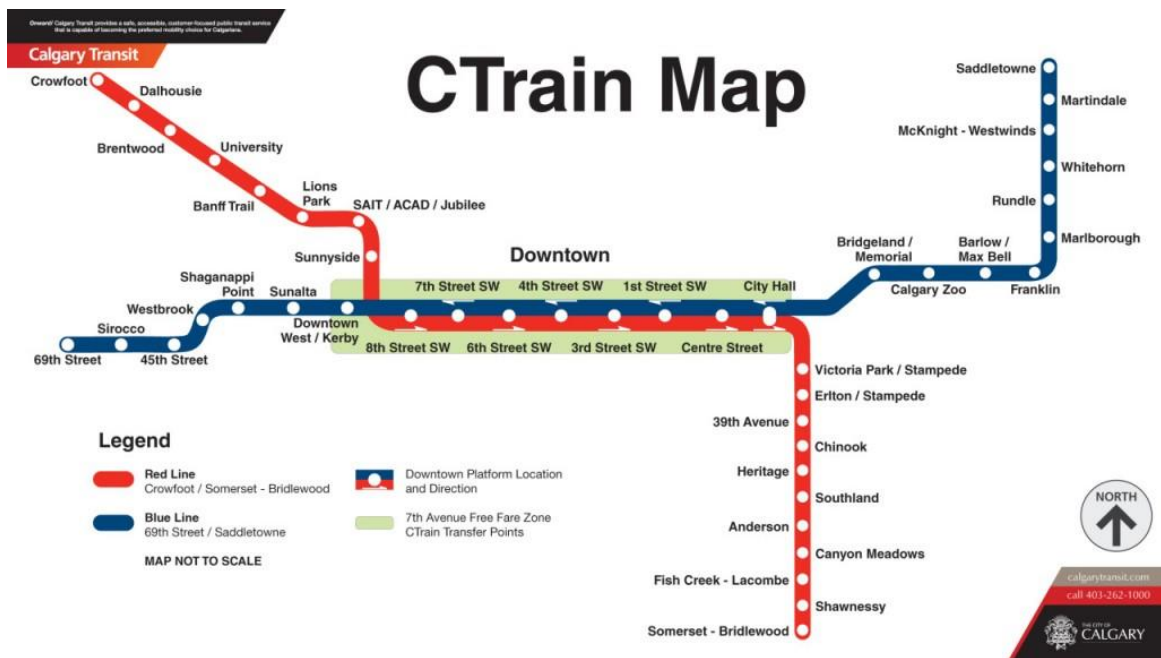
The Marriott Delta Bow Valley Hotel (209 4 Ave SE) is a thirty minute walk or a 20 minute (FREE) LRT/CTrain ride/walk to the Kerby Centre. Please note that the CTrain is FREE only downtown.

Delta Hotel to Kerby Centre (via C-Train): Walk south on Macleod Trail SE to the **WB (westbound) City Hall C-Train Station** on 7th Ave SE (north side of street). Take the **69th St Station** train and get off at the **WB Downtown – West Kerby CTrain Station**. Walk west to 1133-7th Ave. SW (1 min). > [click for map](#)

Kerby Centre to Delta Hotel (via C-Train): Walk East on 7th Ave to the **EB Downtown – West Kerby CTrain Station** (south side of street). Take the **Saddletown or Somerset-Bridlewood** train and get off at the **EB Centre St CTrain Station**. Walk north on Centre St to hotel on 4th Ave SE. > [click for map](#)
