Pigs connects to the curriculum:

- **Grades K-6:** Links to art, language arts, music, and drama for all grades
- **Grade 1 Social Studies: Canada's past:** The title story is based on an historic recount of transporting seven pigs down the Red River to Winnipeg in 1817.
- **Grade 2 Science: Water Cycle:** A puppet water droplet cycles through the water phases of liquid, solid and vapour as well as going through the inside of a cow, a freezer, a sewer and more!
- **Grade 3 Science: Ocean Life:** Different sea life and ocean habitat is introduced, in a beautiful shadow puppet section, when a puppet asks "How deep is the sea?"
- **Grade 4 Science: Waste/Reuse/Recycle/Reduce:** The Greedy Frog, with puppets from recycled materials, is an environmental tale related to modern water issues.
